

NASSAU GROUPER ARE CRITICALLY ENDANGERED!












In 2018, Nassau Grouper joined the ranks of other critically endangered species; that is, those that are at extremely high risk of extinction within three generations or approximately 10 years.

THE DECLINE

- Commercial landings of Nassau Grouper in The Bahamas have declined since 2011
- Several spawning aggregations have collasped, including the largest known aggregation in The Bahamas
- We need to ensure the population is sustainable, especially during winter full moons, when spawning occurs
